



A-G table for UC & CSU / Community College requirements

University Admission Requirements: To qualify for admission you must meet the subject, GPA & exam requirements. A student must receive *no lower than a "C" grade in college prep and AP/Honors courses* to be eligible for a four-year university. To meet the university admission requirements, students need to get *mostly A & B grades*. Students need *close to a 3.0 academic grade point average (GPA)* or better.

		<p>The community college offers many Career Technical Education (CTE) classes as well as a transfer program that allows students to move on to a four-year college.</p> <p>At community colleges, any student may be admitted who is either a high school graduate or 18 years of age, or who has passed GED or California High School Proficiency Exam.</p> <p>Note: Selected community college courses are available to high school students. Students must see their counselor for a referral form and concurrent enrollment form. To count as credit on AVHS transcript, student must have official college transcript sent to the AVHS registrar. Please see counselor for referral form and more information.</p>

G	COLLEGE-PREPARATORY ELECTIVE	1 year: Any approved college-preparatory course, including advanced math, science, foreign language, social sciences, visual & performing arts, economics.		
	GPA	UC: Min. 3.0, depending on campus & SAT/ACT score	CSU: Min. 2.0, depending on campus & SAT/ACT score	No GPA requirement
	EXAMS	ACT with Writing or SAT. (Tip: Take it twice—once at the end of 11 th and again at the beginning of 12 th grade.)		No SAT or ACT scores required
